A contract of sale is a legal contract. It is a contract for the exchange of goods, services or property that are the subject of exchange from seller (or vendor) to buyer (or purchaser) for an agreed upon value in money (or money equivalent) paid or the promise to pay same. It is a specific type of legal contract. The Sale of Goods Act 1979 says goods must be as described, satisfactory quality and fit for purpose. If goods are faulty, you can claim from the retailer.
